



It was a troubled start in Marstrand yesterday. A total of seven boats were disqualified. However, [Magnus](#) and [Göran](#) Olsson from Stockholm were among those who managed.

New winners every day -- USA boat in the lead - still

MARSTRAND: There are new winners every day in Marstrand during the [5-0-5 World Cup](#). Winners in the third race were Dennis Surtees and Steve Owens from San Francisco, USA. During the races that has been, they have finished 3, 4, 1, and with this series they now lead in total.

The key to the success, [Dennis Surtees](#) explained as follows:

- At home in San Francisco it mostly blows a steady wind with a strength of 8-10 m/sec. Under such conditions you learn to sail in strong winds, and so far it has suited us fine here in Marstrand. The misses we made are due to change in wind direction and they are always difficult to parry. If the wind stays the week out, we will probably be able to make a good final finish.

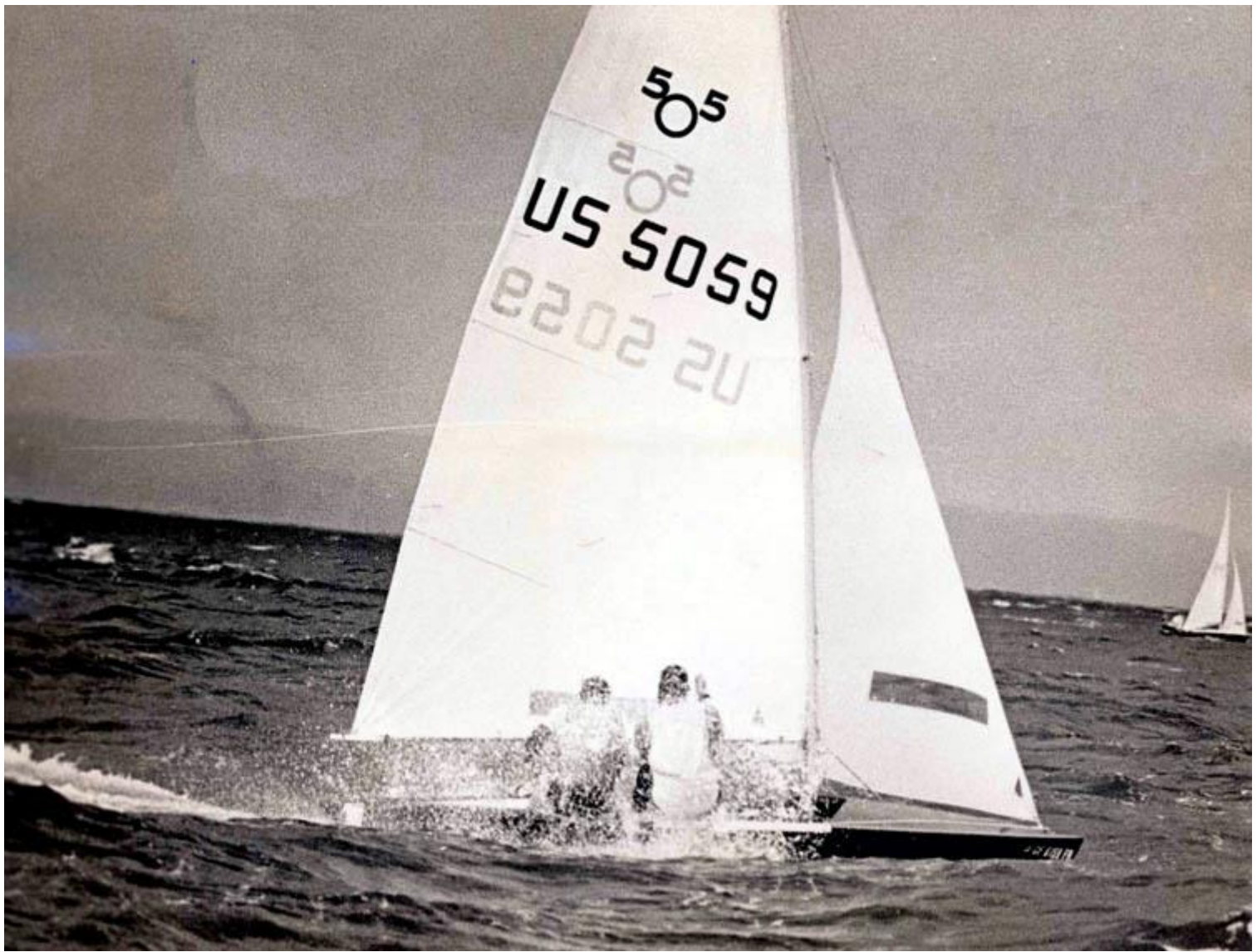


US-5059 Dennis Surtees/Stephen Owens in their 5.05 named Atzuma (Photo: [Kirk Wilson](#))

Yesterday's start was somewhat troubling. After several attempts the race could be started, but seven boats were too early and disqualified, one of them being Mark Bethwaite/Ian McPitt, Australia, who won the second race. They are now out of the game when they have the series 38, 1, DSQ.

The Båth brothers from Gothenburg became also yesterday the best Swedish boat in seventh place. After a bad start they came back strong and through the good placement they are still in the top overall with their serie 6, 3, 7.

The Pajot brothers, France, were also at the top. Occasionally, especially on the downwinds, they sailed faster than the winners Surtees/Owens and were also past, but on the final beat they were clearly distanced. Their serie 1, 9, 2 is promising good for the fourth race today.
